What is Movie Night? Movie Night is an opportunity for parents to have a date night while their kids have fun with friends and siblings at the dojo.

What do the kids eat? The children have pizza & lemonade before the movie and popcorn & pretzels during the movie.

What should my child bring to Movie Night? Please bring a water bottle (one that can be used neatly on the mats during the movie), a pillow and a sleeping bag/blanket - to mark out a movie watching spot & be comfy.

What should my child wear? Play clothes or pajamas

Can my child bring a sibling or friend? Absolutely! Siblings and friends are welcome to join us!

What is the cost? \$15 per student. \$10 per additional student for families with more than 1 student enrolled. \$10 per non-enrolled siblings and/or friends.

How long is Movie Night? Movie Night runs from 5:30 p.m. – 8 p.m.

How do I sign my child up for Movie Night? *Karate families* - complete the Movie Night Registration form and place it in the Red folder on the credenza. *Fun & Fit Aftercare families* – complete the Movie Night Registration form and hand it in when you drop off/pick up your child at F & F.

Who needs waivers? Waivers are needed for friends or siblings who are *not* enrolled in our karate or childcare programs. Students enrolled in our karate or childcare programs do NOT need waivers.
